In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Government of India is commendably rolling out rapid response activities throughout the country. To alleviate the larger impact of the outbreak in India, People to People Health Foundation (PPHF) is supporting Government's efforts to scale up its response to the COVID-19. PPHF is responding to COVID-19 with support from our partners and directly working with the Government at National and State level on:

- 1. Strengthening the health system infrastructure by providing life supporting medical equipment and supplies to COVID-19 hospitals and Quarantine centres;
- 2. Supporting healthcare workers on infection prevention and control; and
- 3. Supporting hygiene promotion activities in the community.

PPHF COVID Response Fund (PCRF): PPHF appreciates our corporate, institutional, and individual donors who have provided funding to PPHF COVID-19 Response Fund (PCRF). The PCRF has and continues to play a critical role in responding to COVID-19 outbreak. To date, in response to COVID-19, we have received funding from Wipro GE Healthcare, Cognizant Foundation, Garrett Advancing Motion, Goodera, Wipro Foundation, Becton, Dickinson and Company, Sanofi-Aventis, and individuals funders. We are also in the process of finalizing new partnerships and collaborations. We have collaborated with central and state governments like, Maharashtra, New Delhi, Karnataka, UP and discussing with other states.

PPHF's COVID-19 Response Update: We are currently supporting two Central Government hospitals in Delhi (Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital and Safdarjung Hospital), one Delhi Government Hospital - Lok Nayak, multiple designated hospitals in Mumbai – like Seven Hills, Bombay Municipal Corporation, Kasturba hospital, Civil hospital Thane, KEM hospital, Parel Mumbai, St. George Hospital, BYL Nair Hospital etc., hospitals in Pune like Sasoon hospital and Bangalore like Sir C.V Raman General hospital and NHM Bangalore (extending support to various isolation centres in Bangalore city and adjoining districts like

Ramanagara) with essential supplies and setting up of dedicated COVID hospitals. We are also facilitating virtual trainings for emergency responders (doctors, nurses, and allied health professionals) in multiple States.

We have installed Foot operated handwashing stations in the urban slums, Primary healthcare clinics like Mohalla clinics in Delhi, government schools, police stations and urban slum clusters for the vulnerable populations to increase access for hand washing. Sensor based hand sanitization stations have been installed at COVID-19 hospitals for the health workers, patients, and their caregivers. In addition, we are partnering with the Education Department of Delhi Government to start an online handwashing program in Delhi schools on COVID-19 for over 1.5 lakh children directly and almost 6 lakh family members through children.




